Hospice Referral Indicators for Non-Cancer Diagnoses

END STAGE CARDIAC DISEASE

- Symptoms of CHF
- Diuretic and/or vasodilator therapy
- Ejection fraction $\leq 20\%$
- Ventricular arrhythmia
- History of cardiac arrest or MI
- Angina at rest

END STAGE PULMONARY DISEASE

- Clinical evidence of severe lung disease
- Dyspnea or hypoxemia at rest
- Increased visit to Emergency Room
- Cor pulmonale
- Weight loss
- Resting tachycardia > 100/min
- $pO_2 < 55$ on oxygen or 88% on room air

STROKE SEQUELAE

- Post-stroke dementia
- Cannot perform ADLs without assistance
- Ability to speak is limited to six or fewer intelligible words
- Weight loss of 10% or serum albumin <2.5 over past six months

DEBILITY UNSPECIFIED

- Weight loss of 10% in last six months
- Functional decline
- Skin integrity issues
- Recurrent infections and/or multiple hospitalizations in past year

END STAGE RENAL DISEASE

- Creatinine clearance < 10cc/mm (<15 cc/mm in diabetics)
- Serum creatinine >8.0 (>6.0 for diabetics)
- Not seeking dialysis (but dialysis patients may be eligible for Hospice benefits)
- Not seeking transplant

END STAGE LIVER DISEASE

- Ascites, hepatorenal syndrome, or hepatic encephalopathy
- Progressive malnutrition & muscle wasting
- Active alcoholism
- Hepatitis B positive
- Awaiting liver transplant
- Prothombin time > 5 seconds
- Serum albumin < 2.5

END STAGE DEMENTIA

- Lack of meaningful communication
- Unable to ambulate independently
- Cannot perform ADLs without assistance
- Incontinent
- In last 12 months had: aspiration pneumonia, UTI, sepsis, multiple decubitus ulcers, or fever

In last 6 months had weight loss of 10% or serum albumin <2.5
